CONVENTION POLICIES

Registration Desk

Upon arrival, this is your first stop. Our knowledgable staff are here to help with your Bricks Cascade experience. You will receive your ID badge and other essentials like MOC display cards and custom engraved bricks.

Check back at the registration desk during the convention to see games rosters, ask for help, and turn in lost items.

Merchandise

Purchase and pick up your Bricks Cascade merchandise at the table next to the Registration Desk. Quantities of some items are limited!

ID Badge

Please wear your badge at all times where it is clearly visible.

This will identify you as a convention attendee and get you into the hall whenever it is open.

IMPORTANT: Security will not let you into the hall without your badge.

MOC

The term "MOC" means My Own Creation. These are the amazing LEGO creations that builders bring here to share with the public.

MOC card

All MOCs should be registered and then displayed with a printed MOC card.

Theme Coordinators

The Theme Coordinator manages placement and handling of MOCs.

If your MOC is large or delicate, work with your Theme Coordinator for custom placement. Generally there is plenty of space for your MOC.

It may be necessary for the Theme Coordinator to move MOCs during set up, so please communicate with them if your MOC is extraordinarily fragile or should not be moved.

General Conduct

The purpose of Bricks Cascade is to have fun and interact with other builders. We ask everyone to conduct themselves in a manner that is respectful and considerate of others.

Attendees may be asked to leave if their behavior is found disruptive to the convention.

CONVENTION POLICIES

Minors

Bricks Cascade is a convention intended for adults. Persons aged 10 to 17 are allowed to register and attend, provided they are accompanied and supervised by an adult who also registers and attends.

Parents and guardians are responsible for the conduct of their children and may be asked to leave if they are disruptive.

We want everyone to have a good time, so please make sure your children are behaving in a respectful and considerate manner.

Selling and Trading

Only registered vendors are allowed to buy, sell, or trade with the public.

Bricks Cascade attendees are welcome to sell and trade amongst themselves as fellow LEGO enthusiasts.

We have created blocked time and locations in the schedule; Garage Sale and Swag Swap. These events are for attendee trading. We ask attendees to refrain from this activity in the hall during Public Expo hours.

GAMES

IMPORTANT:

Game sign-ups were available online to registered attendees. Please check at Registration for what games you are scheduled to play. Game assignments were made on preferences and available slots.

If you did not sign up online but want to play, arrive early to the game and sign up as a stand-by player. Stand-by players will be assigned slots if registered players do not attend.

Stand-by is on a first come, first served basis.

Wacky Racers

Thurs, 2:00 PM, Hall A

Bring a wheeled (or just rounded) vehicle to roll down the Wacky Race ramp. All entries must have a pilot and be powered only by gravity.

Brick Derby

Thurs, 3:30 PM, Hall A

The LEGO version of a pinewood derby. We supply the track, you supply the racers. This is a head-to-head race. Winners advance, losers crash!

Car must:

- 1. Be built from LEGO elements.
- 2. Not exceed 10 ounces.
- 3. Fit inside a box with a 9x23 stud interior (no height limit).
- 4. Clear the track: minimum 5 studs between left and right wheels, minimum two plates high.
- 5. Be gravity powered. No wind-ups, motors, etc. (Springs for suspension are allowed).
- 6. Use dry lubricant (graphite, silicone, Teflon, etc.)

Speed Build

#1 Fri,10:30 AM, A108

#2 Sat, 2:30 PM, A108

Players are provided a set to build as quickly as possible. First to accurately complete the set wins.

Minifig Mecha Makeover

Fri, 10:30 AM, A104

Collaborative build. Participants bring a minifig (any minifig that is special to them) and loose parts that suit their chosen minifig. A blank Mecha frame is provided to customize for the minifigure. All the Mechs will be displayed together in the Mecha theme during public hours, and participants take theirs home at the end.

Techno Challenge

Fri, 10:30 AM, A107

Players are provided a Technic set and must build something other than the set. Creations are judged on creativity, originality, and overall pieces used.

Team Speed Build

Fri, 1:00 PM, Hall A

Teammates work together to build a large LEGO set as quickly as possible. First team to accurately complete the set, wins.

Master Build

Fri, 1:30 PM, A104

Players are provided sets and a theme to freestyle build to. Creations will be judged based on creativity, originality, and overall pieces used.

Box Build

Fri, 1:30 PM, A107

Players are given a set with no instructions. They must build the set based on the images on the box. First player done with fewest unused pieces, wins.

Build in a Bag

Fri. 2:00 PM. A108

The pieces from a set are emptied into a ziploc bag and sealed. The players build the set as quickly as they can without opening the bag. First player to accurately complete the set, wins.

Draft

#1 Retro Roller Skate - 31148

Fri. 3:30 PM. A108

#2 Escape from the Lost Tomb - 77013

Sat. 10:30 AM, A108

To participate, bring an unopened copy of one or both LEGO sets. In a Draft, several copies of the same set are opened and sorted into individual piles of unique shape or color. Each player takes one pile for their own. Participation is unlimited. No need to sign up!

Builder's Dash

Fri, 3:30 PM, A104

Players are given a set, and the pieces are placed on a table on one side of the room, with the instructions on the other side. Players must then race back and forth to complete the set as quickly as possible.

GAMES

One-Handed Build

Fri, 3:30 PM, A107

Players are allowed to use only one hand for all building. Two hands may be used to open the boxes and baggies, but once the building begins, only one hand may be over the table surface at a time. Time penalties are assessed for violations. First to accurately complete the set, wins.

Pair Build

Sat, 10:30 AM, A107

Two players sit facing each other with a shroud between them. One has the instructions and the other has the provided set. One player gives verbal instructions without seeing the bricks or the progress, and the other player builds based off of verbal instructions without seeing the instructions. The pair can only verbally communicate. First pair to accurately complete the set, wins.

Dirty Brickster

Sat, 1:00 PM, A108

Players sit around a table loaded with wrapped gifts and take turns choosing to open or steal a gift. A gift becomes "locked" on its third steal and cannot be stolen again. You provide a wrapped gift. Participation is unlimited. No need to sign up.

The Claw

Sat, 1:30 PM, A107

Two players sit facing each other with a shroud between them. One of the players has their hands through the shroud to build the set and is not allowed to see their hands, pieces, or instructions and the other player can see the hands, the set, and instructions. Players must verbally communicate so the hands can build the set as quickly and accurately as possible. First pair to accurately complete the set, wins.

Blind Build

#1 Sat, 3:30 PM, A107

#2 Sun, 10:30 AM A107

Players are provided a set but seated with a shroud placed before them that their hands easily fit through. The instructions are outside of the shroud and the pieces are inside with the player. First to complete with relative accuracy, wins.

3-in-1

Sun. 10:30 AM, A108

Players are given a 3-in-1 set and race to complete all versions of the set. Build the first, have it verified, tear it apart, build the second, have it verified, tear it apart, build the third, have it verified. First to accurately complete the set, wins.

Lights On-Lights Off

Sun, 10:30 AM, A109

Players will be provided a set. With the lights on, players study their instructions without building. The lights are turned off, and players must blind-build the set from memory until the lights are turned back on. Again they can only study instructions and any corrections they might need to make. Then its Lights Off and GO! This repeats until a winner is declared.

Scavenger Hunt

Sun. 1:30 PM. A108

Find and photograph each item, all found somewhere in the convention hall. Then return to base for your score. Missing or inadequate items will add time. Creative and technically correct answers welcome! PHONE OR DIGITAL CAMERA REQUIRED.

Standing Speed Build

Sun. 1:30 PM. A109

Players are provided a set to build as quickly as possible while holding all the pieces to the set in their hands. If any piece falls they must quickly pick them up before they resume building. First to accurately complete the set, wins.

99 Pieces

Sun, 1:30 PM, A107

In this challenge, you select and bring the most versatile collection of LEGO elements – a total of 99 pieces. You will be challenged to build to an idea or theme in just 3 minutes. You will play head-to-head against other builders. The audience will choose their favorite construction. Then you will take apart your masterpiece and begin again with a different challenge. There will be several challenges to tackle. The builder with the most points as voted on by the observers, wins. Bring on your best!

Sunday, 2:00 PM, A104


This is an opportunity for attendees to sell or trade to one another. Bring old kits or parts from home, or trade some of your swaq and prizes.






